The Massachusetts Housing Leadership Academy is CHAPA's free, six-month fellowship designed for:

- Mayors
- City and Town Councilors
- Select Board Members
- Planning Board Members
- Zoning Board of Appeals Members
- Finance Committee Members
- Members of boards and commissions who can impact housing

- Build a deeper understanding of the Commonwealth's housing challenges and local housing solutions that can address them
- Receive expert guidance and one-on-one support from CHAPA's award-winning Education and Action team on community engagement strategies to build local support for housing creation
- Join a community of leaders and peers dedicated to building more vibrant, affordable communities

Program Components:

- Monthly virtual cohort meetings with local officials for peer-to-peer learning and direct support
- Monthly virtual seminars led by expert speakers on:
 - Root causes of Massachusetts' housing challenges
 - Policy tools available to local communities to spur housing production
 - Effective community engagement, messaging, and political organizing
- Social events to connect with other Massachusetts housing leaders
- Optional one-on-one community engagement consulting and direct support from CHAPA's Education and Action team



The Massachusetts Housing Leadership Academy requires a time commitment of roughly 25 hours over the course of six months. Fellows are expected to attend all cohort meetings and workshops.
